



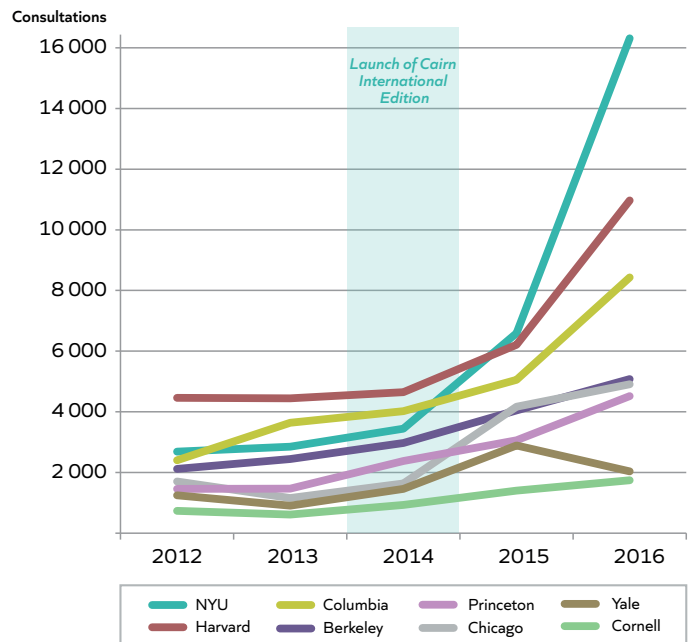
Progress Report for Cairn

International Edition: growth of the international visibility of francophone journals in social sciences and humanities

In 2014, Cairn.info and its partners launched **Cairn International Edition**, an English-language platform offering translations of abstracts and articles from key francophone journals in social sciences and humanities. The ambition of the project was to increase the visibility and usage of French-language publications among non-francophone students and researchers.

Three years after the launch of the project, the number of non-francophone universities with a subscription to Cairn.info has passed the 150 mark:

- United States 31 universities
- United Kingdom 19 universities
- China 10 universities
- Spain 9 universities
- Japan 8 universities
- Italy 6 universities
- Germany 5 universities
- The Netherlands 5 universities
- Australia 3 universities



The international community of Cairn.info subscribers includes 35 of the top 50 universities for social sciences and humanities according to the 2018 *Times Higher Education* World University Ranking. Moreover, the volume of consultations has been multiplied by 6 since 2014, to reach around 50,000 articles read every month in non-francophone universities.



In 2017 Cairn.info partnered up with the magazine *Books* with the support of the Centre Français d'exploitation du droit de Copie to publish *Monthly Dossiers*: an in-depth presentation of a selection of articles on a specific topic in current affairs, taken from journals available on Cairn.info.

The goal of the *Monthly Dossiers* is to highlight what's being published in the francophone world in the fields of social sciences and humanities by providing a practical and global context to the work of selected scholars.
